Cooling – Absorption and compressor type central air conditioning systems, cooling tower operations

Hot water – Different ways how hot water is made and distributed

Elevators – Elevator systems will be discussed and new codes as well as maintenance issues

Plumbing – Basic plumbing systems of buildings and how the water is circulated in low rise and high rise buildings. Drainage and Venting will also be explained and discussed
